





A Tribute



Principal Harbhajan Singh (1891-1962)

"Let there be no inscription upon my tomb. Let no man write my epitaph. Let my character and motives repose in obscurity and peace, till other times and other men can do them justice". Robert Emmet's words dating back to 1803 perhaps reflect the innate qualities of visionaries, usually legends in their lifetimes who have inspired generations.

And for thousands of Punjabis, particularly from Mahilpur, settled in India and abroad the late Principal Harbhajan Singh remains a beacon of inspiration through his ideals. His contribution in making Mahilpur a football centre as well as a seat of higher learning remains unparalleled and unmatched.

Born at Mahilpur on January 9,1891, to Tehsildar Natha Singh Bains and Mrs Kishan Kaur, Principal Harbhajan Singh died issueless in 1962. But in a career spanning four decades, he achieved what many could only dream of, without craving for materialistic gains. His missionary zeal and dedication to the cause of education and sports can be gauged from the fact that he did not draw a single rupee as salary while discharging his duties as Principal of Sri Guru Gobind Singh Khalsa College, Mahilpur, for 15 years until shortly before his death in 1962. Moreover, he donated his life's earnings and property to the college after steering the institution to a position of eminence. Thus from a remote and obscure village in Hoshiarpur district, Mahilpur acquired the status of not only a prominent educational centre but also as a nursery of football. No wonder, eminent Army officers, bureaucrats and footballers of Punjab, both past and present, have been indebted to Principal Harbhajan Singh for their illustrious careers. They include independent India's first Defence Minister, Mr Baldev Singh, the late Lieut-Gen PS Gyani, Lieut-Gen KS Gill, Lieut-Gen NS Bal, Mai-Gen Gian Singh, Col Surinder Singh Bains, former Olympian Jarnail Singh, Justice Ajit Singh Bains, former PSEB Engineer-in-Chief Harbans Singh Bains, who is also Chairman of the Principal Harbhajan Singh Sporting Club, and many more.

Having lost his father in childhood, Harbhajan Singh grew up under the watchful eyes of his uncle, Mr. Dalip Singh and tutor, Munshi Fateh Singh who imbibed in him the qualities of the head and heart. Quick in learning, the young Harbhajan was awarded scholarships for the fifth and eighth standard examinations which he passed from the District Board Vernacular Middle School. Later he did his matriculation from DAV High School, Hoshiarpur, in 1911 and FA from Khalsa College, Amritsar. For graduation, he shifted to DAV College, Lahore, from where he passed his BA examination in 1915. Later, having done BT from Government Central Training College, Lahore, he joined as Headmaster at Khalsa High School, Ambala. Later he served as Headmaster at Malwa High School, Ludhiana for two years, and Khalsa High School, Kharar for a year before taking over as Headmaster at Khalsa High School ,Mahilpur. Within a short span, the Mahilpur school earned statewide recognition in education and sports. Students from far and near sought admission and the institution earned a name in disciplines like football, tug-of-war, and hockey with Principal Harbhajan Singh personally supervising practice sessions.

In the early forties the idea to set up a degree college caught the fancy of Principal Harbhajan Singh and the dream took concrete shape in 1946 when he paid a guarantee money of s 85,000 to Panjab University from his own savings and was later made founder Principal, the post which he held until shortly before his death.

When Principal Harbhajan Singh breathed his last on August 16, 1962, a meeting of grief-stricken admirers having decided to perpetuate his memory resolved to constitute a panel to carry forward his mission. Accordingly, a committee was constituted which decided to start the Principal Harbhajan Singh Memorial Football Tournament on an annual basis. The first edition of the tournament was organized in October-November 1962, and the practice continued till 1965.

In 1966, the Harbhajan Sporting Club came into existence which assumed responsibility for conducting the tournament. Dr. Narinder Pal was the founder President of the club. Ever since there has been interruption and increased interest of N.R.I's has given the tournament further boost. The 53rd edition of the tournament currently under way at Mahilpur offers over Rs 1 lakh in prize money. Among the sponsors are the Principal Harbhajan Singh Educational and Sports Society, Vancouver, and the Principal Harbhajan Singh Memorial Trust also based in Canada.

The Legendary Jarnail Singh Arjuna Awardee

Is regarded as one of the most outstanding defenders to have donned the Indian colours. The natural athlete that he was, Jarnail took the art of defense to new heights making himself an epitome of strength and stamina.


Like many of his illustrious compatriots, Jarnail played a pivotal role in shaping India's football fortunes during the golden era of Indian football.

His heroics in the 1962 Jakarta Asian Games are part of Indian football folklore now. Braving a nasty head-injury that required six stitches, Jarnail, in his new avatar as a forward, scored crucial goals in the semi-final and final to fetch India its maiden Asiad football gold. Two years later, when India became the runner-up in the 1964 Asia Cup at Tel Aviv, Jarnail was at his best marshalling the defence with authority and guile.

After another commendable show at the Merdeka tournament in Malaysia in the same year, Jarnail took over the reins of the team from Chuni Goswami and continued for more than two seasons with a fair bit of success.

At the domestic circuit, Jarnail was associated with the Mohun Bagan Club for 10 glorious years when the green-and-maroon team swept all the major titles at the national level. After quitting from Mohun Bagan in 1969, Jarnail went to play for Punjab and inspired the teram to win the first Santosh Trophy in 1970 as a coach-cum-player.

In July 2000 Jarnail Singh (64), widower, had gone to visit his son Harash Singh in Vancouver (Canada). While on his visit he was rushed to hospital after he complained of breathlessness. Later that day, **13th October 2000** the Legend Jarnail Singh passed away due to an asthmatic disorder.

Inder singh Arjuna Awardee



PHAGWARA football and 63-year-old Inder Singh are almost synonymous. This recipient of the Arjuna Award strode the Indian football firmament like a colossus for over two decades. With his speed, stamina and killer instinct, he scripted victory easily. Having joined the Leader Club in 1960 and the JCT in 1974, he played for Punjab from 1962-1978, for India from 1963-1975. He captained the Indian team thrice in 1969, 1973 and 1975. He won the Arjuna Award in 1969.

It was his scoring ability that won him laurels. His shielding of the ball from the immediate marker was marvellous, according to experts. His record of 23 goals in the Santosh Trophy Tournament held in Punjab in 1974 has not been beaten till date. Punjab had defeated Bengal then by 6-0 goals in the final and Inder Singh alone had scored three goals. The Punjab team scored a total of 46 goals in the tournament out of which as many as 23 goals were scored were scored by Inder Singh!

He was selected in the Asian All-Stars team in 1967-1968. He was declared the "Best Right Out" in Asian Cup held at Tel Aviv in Israel in 1964. India was the runner-up there. He played for the JCT from 1974 to 1985. After his retirement, he was the manager of the JCT from 1985 to 2001. Since November 2001 he has been the Honorary Secretary of Punjab Football Association and also represents as member from North India in All India Football Federation's Executive Committee.

Inder Singh played in the Merdeka Football Tournament in Malaysia . Interestingly, the then-Prime-Minister of Malaysia, Mr Tinku Abdul Rehman, became his fan so much so that he offered him a monthly salary of Rs 23,000 in 1967!The PM offered him five years' contract. But Inder Singh turned down the offer, as he wanted to play for Punjab and India. "some of my friends then called me a sentimental fool to have rejected the offers," recalls Inder Singh. Later, the Mohan Bangan Club of West Bengal offered him a blank cheque. The Khalsa Sporting Club, Canada, also mada a plum offers to him, but he stuck to his roots.



Asian Star Footballer



Parminder Singh (renowned as Asian Star Footballer) joined JCT as Football Coach in the year 1995. He is graduate and has done Diploma in Football Coaching from Sports Authority of India (NIS Diploma) and has done AFC (Asian Football Confederation) "A", "B"& "C" Licence Coaching Courses. Besides this he has done AFC "B"& "C" Licence Conditioning Courses. He was one of the participants in FIFA Futuro-III Administration & Management Course which was conducted at AIFF Football House, New Delhi. During His playing career, Mr. Parminder Singh Kang has set a record of playing 19 years for JCT and in that period he had represented JCT in19 Federation Cups, 19 Santosh Trophies. He had the honour to represent India Team in various International Assignments in the years 1975 to 1986. Mr. Parminder Singh Kang has brought Laurels for JCT and Punjab State by winning Major ALL India Tournaments for JCT and Santosh Trophies for Punjab State. He was declared as "Best Player of the decades" by AIFF in the year 1992. He had the honour to represented India as member of "Asian All Star Football Team". He was conferred with " Maharaja Ranjit Singh Award" (a top level state award) by Government of Punjab in the year 1983. He was also declared as "Best Player of the year 1984" by Delhi Sports Journalists Association, New Delhi.

Surinder Singh Rai – Footballing Biography

Growing up in Moranwali, Surinder Singh Rai showed from an early age what a talented sportsman he was by winning numerous compititions and trophies both as a track and field athlete and as a footballer at school level. He pursued his footballing dreams by regularly putting in commendable performances as the 1st choice goalkeeper for the Sports School, Jalandhar, which led to him being selected for the Punjab Schools Football Team in 1972 to 1973. These performances led to further recognition when he was selected in 1973 at only the age of 18 to play for the Punjab Under 20 state team.

When studying for his BA at Mahilpur College from 1974-1977 and his MA at the Govt. College Hoshiarpur from 1978-1979, Surinder regularly played for them as the 1st choice goalkeeper and captained them to much success. Throughout this time, he was a permanent fixture in the Punjab University football team for 6 years including captaining them for the 1978 season. Also he was selected the best Athlete among boys for the year 1976-77 at Mahilpur college.

Surinder's heroic displays in goal were the talk of the footballing community in India. As a result, he was to go on and play regularly for the Indian Universities Combined Football Team from 1976-1979, where he felt a great deal of pride and honour in representing his nation in every game. He has since emigrated to the UK where he has lived for over 30 years with his family but still feels humbled by the level of respect afforded to him by the Mahilpur footballing community and wishes them every success for the future.

FAMOUS FOOTBALL TOURNAMENTS OF INDIA

Santosh Trophy

Santosh Trophy is an annual Indian football tournaments which is contested by states and government institutions. The first winners were Bengal, who lead the all – time winners list with 29 titles til date. The tournaments first Began in 1941, and was the premier football competition in the country before the National Football League started in the year 1996. The trophy as named after the late Maharaja Sir Manmatha Nath Roy Chowdhary of Santosh, which is now in Bangladesh, who had been the President of the Indian Football Association, the football organization of Bengal the donators by the IFA. The third place teams receive the Sampangi Cup which was presented by the Mysore Football Association (now KSFA) IN 1952, IN THE MEMORY OF Sampangi, a renowned footballer from Mysore. The competition has seen a few changes in the format through the years. In the present format, there is a qualifying round involving eight clusters of three or four teams each. The eight winners from each cluster are then drawn along and they play a knock out round with each other. The winners along with the four seeded teams (Who do not have to come through qualifying) are then divided into two groups of four each. This is the quarterfinal league stage, in which each of the four teams in the group play each other. The top two teams of each group then move to the semifinals. The semifinals and the final are single – legged fixture, with extra time, golden goal and penalty shootout, if required.

Durand Cup

The Durand football tournament was started by then, India's foreign secretary, Mortimer Durand at Simla, India, in 1888. The initial matches were played in dagshiai. It was bascilly intiated, as a recreation for British troops stationed in India. The Durand Cup was twice suspended, during the the two world wars. In venues was shifted New Delhi. Since India's independence in 1947, the tournament is hosted by the army and is held at the Ambedkar Stadium in Delhi. Mohan Bagan (16x) and East Bengal (16x) have split 32 cup victories between them. After the eclipse of the high profile teames from Hyderabad, the Durand Cup, with rare exceptions since 1970, has been won mostly by teams from Kolkata (Mohan Bagan and East Bengal) or Punjab (Brother Security Force & JCT Mills). In 1997 FC Kochin from the south won, in 1998 and 2002 for the first time a team from Mumbai, Mahindra United won the tital twice, while in 1999 and 2003 Goan side Salgaocar won by Mohan Bagan. In 2005 Sporting Clube de goa missed the title by a whisker when Army XI produced an upset to win. But in 2006 it was won by Goa's Dempo S.C., Who beat JCT (2-0) in the finals Resent seasons has been dominated by Churchill Brothers from Goa. They won the tournament twice in 2007 and 2009, while finishing 2nd in 2008. The winning team is presented with three trophies -The President's Cup (First Presented by Dr. Rajendra Parsad India's first President) The Durand Cup (The original challenge prize, which is a rolling trophy) The Shimla Trophy (First presented by citizens of Shimla in 1904 and since 1965 it is a rolling trophy)

Fedration Cup

Fedration Cup is India's first major competition involving the clubs. It was instituted by the All India Football Fedration in 1977. Over the years, there has been a change in format of the tournament. But it became Indai's prominent football tournament in the eighties and even in the early nineties. After I-League, it is India's most popular and prestigious tournaments which involves all the major club teams. It is played in a Knock-out basis.

I League

I league is the top tier league in the Indian football league system. It was started in the 2007-2008 and the first edition was inaugurated by the Prime Minister Sh. Manmohan Singh. It replaced the National Football League which lasted for 11 seasons. The I League over the years has aimed to professionalize the league system in India. I – League now is a separate legal entity and professionally structured with a full time CEO. The first game was played on 24 November 2007 and was contested between Dempo Sports Club and salgaocar Club which the former won by a three goal margin.

I League has 2 divisions i.e Ist and 2nd where in the relegated teams from the Ist division move

To the lower division and the top teams from the 2nd division move on the higher division every year. The

First National Football League was held in 1996-97 with 8 Teams and JCT where the winners and Churchill

Brothers, Goa finished Runners Up. The aim was to develop professionalism in Indian Football. In 1997-98

the number of teams was raised to 10 and in 1998-99 it was raised to 12 teams. The system of relegation

started in the 3rd National Football League. Two teams where promoted and two teams were relegated.

In the 2004-05 season, four teams were relegated and only two teams were Promoted. The number of

teams in the 2011-12 season is 14.

Stadiums in India

Examples of great stadiums in India are M.A. Chidamdaram Stadium in Chennai, Punjab Cricket Association Stadium in Mohali, and the Wankhede Stadium in Mumbai but they are all primarily Cricket Stadiums. The best reported football stadiums in India are Fatorda Stadiums in Goa, Salt lake Stadium in Kolkata, and cooperage Ground in Mumbai but the best rated football stadium in India is Shree Shiv Chhatrapati Sports Complex in Pune. The reasons the football stadiums in India are rated so poorly is because of the lack of flood lights, lack of actual seats in the stands, and because the condition of the pitches are poor. So for only the Shree Shiv Chhatrapati Sports Complex has fulfilled all of those criteria regarding seating, floodlights, and pitch condition.

Interesting Facts

In 1997 Nigerian international Celestine Babayaro broke his leg while celebrating a goal in his Chelsea debut during a preseason game.

In 1998 English referee Martin Sylvester sent himself off after punching a payer during a game in the Andover and District Sunday League.

In 1938, in the World Cup semifinal, Guiseppe Meazza of Italy's shorts fell down as he was taking a penalty shot. He held his shorts up and calmly scored past Brazil's Valter.

In 1970, the legendary coaches, Jock Stein and Brian Clough both had 44 day stints at Leeds United.

Under Herbert Chapman, The Arsenal changed their name to simply Arsenal in order to appear at the top of the alphabetical list of old Division One clubs.

Sir Stanley Mathews never received a booking in his 33 year long career.

Michael Laudrup appeared for Real Madrid in 5-0 win over Barcelona and also Barcelona when they beat Real Madrid 5-0.

Luigi Riva once broke the arm of a spectator with one of his powerful shots.

20 red cards were shown during a 1993 game between Spotivo Ameliano and General Caballero in Paraguay.

ASEC Abidjan of Cote D'Ivoire went unbeaten for 108 games between 1989 and 1994.

Carlos Caszely of Chile was the first player red carded in a World Cup tournament on June 14,1974.

European Teams have reached the final of every World Cup except in 1930 and 1950.

Goalkeeper Arthur Wharton was the first black professional soccer player. He was born in Ghana (then Gold Coast) and played for English League team Rotherham United in 1889.

In 1950 India withdrew from the World Cup because FIFA refused to let their team play barefoot.

In 1954 Turkey knocked out Spain from during a World Cup qualifier by drawing straws. Blindfolded Italian boy Luigi Franco Gemma picked the straws to decide the winner.

In 1957 with only 30 minutes remaining, Charlton Athletic game back from a 5-1 deficit to defeat Huddersfield Town 7-6.

In 1968, Penarol of Urugauy conceded only five goals in 18 games on the way to an unbeaten season.

In 1996 George Weah paid for his teammates uniforms and expenses so that Liberia could enter the African Nations Cup.
