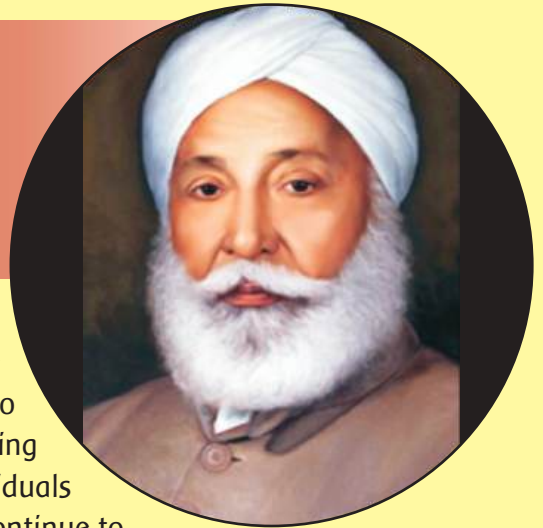

A Tribute to PRINCIPAL HARBHAJAN SINGH (1891-1962)



"Let there be no inscription upon my tomb. Let no man write my epitaph. Let my character and motives repose in obscurity and peace until other times and other men can do them justice." These timeless words by Robert Emmet, dating back to 1803, capture the essence of true visionaries—individuals whose contributions resonate beyond their lifetimes and continue to inspire generations. Principal Harbhajan Singh, a revered figure among Punjabis, particularly those from Mahilpur, exemplified this visionary spirit. His transformative work in education and sports established Mahilpur as both an academic hub and a nursery of football, leaving an indelible mark on the region. Born on January 9, 1891, in Mahilpur to Tehsildar Natha Singh Bains and Kishan Kaur, Harbhajan Singh grew up under the care of his uncle, Dalip Singh, and tutor, Munshi Fateh Singh, after losing his father in childhood. Demonstrating academic brilliance from an early age, he earned scholarships during his schooling years. After completing his matriculation in 1911 and his FA from Khalsa College, Amritsar, he graduated from DAV College, Lahore, in 1915 and pursued a BT from Government Central Training College, Lahore. This academic journey laid the foundation for a career dedicated to education.

Harbhajan Singh began his professional journey as Headmaster at Khalsa High School, Ambala, and later served in similar capacities in Ludhiana and Kharar before taking over Khalsa High School, Mahilpur. Under his leadership, Mahilpur emerged as a center of excellence in both academics and sports. The school gained renown for its achievements in football, tug-of-war, and hockey, with Principal Harbhajan Singh personally mentoring students in their practice sessions. Driven by a vision to expand educational opportunities, he founded Sri Guru Gobind Singh Khalsa College, Mahilpur, in 1946. Remarkably, he guaranteed Rs. 85,000 from his own savings to Panjab University to establish the college. Serving as its first Principal, he held the post without drawing a salary for 15 years, dedicating his life and resources to the institution's growth. His efforts turned Mahilpur into a prominent educational and sports hub, producing notable figures such as India's first Defence Minister Baldev Singh, Lieut-Gen P.S. Gyani, and Olympian Jarnail Singh etc. Principal Harbhajan Singh's passing on August 16, 1962, left a profound void. To honor his legacy, his admirers initiated the Principal Harbhajan Singh Memorial Football Tournament, first held in 1962. By 1966, the Harbhajan Sporting Club was formed to organize the event annually, further amplifying his contributions. Support from organizations such as the Principal Harbhajan Singh Educational and Sports Society in Vancouver and the Principal Harbhajan Singh Memorial Trust in Canada has helped sustain and expand the tournament.

Principal Harbhajan Singh's life was a testament to selfless service, unwavering dedication, and visionary leadership. His legacy continues to inspire generations, embodying the ideals of education, sportsmanship, and community service.

S. Jarnail Singh Arjuna Awardee



Scored the winning goal in the 1962 Jakarta Asian Games, securing India's Gold Medal
Awarded the prestigious Arjuna Award in 1964
Captained the Indian Football Team from 1965 to 1967
The only Indian to captain the Asian All-Star Football team
Jarnail Singh Dhillon was one of the most influential footballers of his time, widely remembered for his exceptional skills as a defender. He played an instrumental role in India's golden era of football during the 1950s and 1960s. A key member of the national squad, Jarnail's contributions to the sport cemented his

place as one of India's finest footballers.

Early Life and Career Beginnings

Jarnail Singh Dhillon was born in 1936 in Panam, a village in Hoshiarpur district, Punjab. His football journey began at the young age of 16 when he started playing for Khalsa College, Mahilpur, in 1952, where he showcased his burgeoning talent. From 1956 to 1957, he played for the Khalsa Sporting Club, and then moved to Rajasthan Club in Calcutta during 1957-1958. Jarnail's major career breakthrough came when he joined Mohun Bagan Athletic Club, Calcutta, in 1958, where he played for an impressive 10 years until 1968.

Remarkable Contributions to Indian Football

Jarnail Singh's career is marked by numerous memorable contributions, but his match-winning performance in the 1962 Asian Games Final stands out. Despite suffering a head injury in the quarterfinals and receiving six stitches, he displayed incredible resolve, continuing to play through the pain. His most heroic moment came in the final against South Korea, where he scored the decisive header to secure India's first-ever Gold Medal in football at the Asian Games. Just two years after his Asian Games triumph, Jarnail further solidified his legacy during the 1964 Asia Cup in Israel, where India earned a Silver Medal. His leadership qualities were also evident, as he captained the Indian national team from 1965 to 1967, guiding them through several crucial matches.

Domestic Success and Mentorship

On the domestic front, Jarnail had a successful tenure with Mohun Bagan, where he helped the club achieve numerous titles. His influence extended beyond club football as he mentored the Punjab football team. Under his leadership, Punjab won its first-ever Santosh Trophy in 1970. The team achieved further success in 1974 when they defeated Bengal 6-0 in the final to win the prestigious trophy again.

Other Achievements

Jarnail Singh's career is further distinguished by his role as the only Indian footballer to captain the Asian All-Star Football team in 1966. After retiring from professional football, he continued to contribute to the sport as a sports administrator. He served as the Deputy Director of Sports for Punjab from 1985 to 1990 and later as the Director of Sports from 1990 to 1994. In recognition of his immense contribution to Indian football, Jarnail was awarded the Arjuna Award in 1964, one of the highest honors for an Indian sportsman. 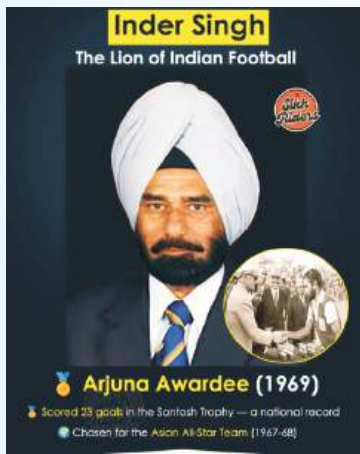

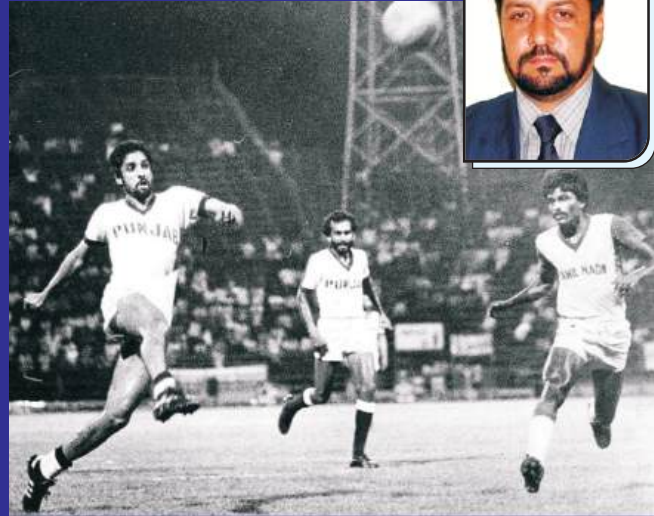
Phagwara footballer and 63-year-old Inder Singh are almost synonymous. This recipient of the Arjuna Award strode the Indian football firmament like a colossus for over two decades. With his speed, stamina and killer instinct, he scripted victory easily. Having joined the Leader Club in 1960 and the JCT in 1974, he played for Punjab from 1962-1978, for India from 1963-1975. He captained the Indian team thrice in 1969, 1973 and 1975. He won the Arjuna Award in 1969.

It was his scoring ability that won him laurels. His shielding of the ball from the immediate marker was marvellous, according to experts. His record of 23 goals in the Santosh Trophy Tournament held in Punjab in 1974 has not been beaten till date. Punjab had defeated Bengal then by 6-0 goals in the final and Inder Singh alone had scored three goals. The Punjab team scored a total of 46 goals in the tournament out of which as many as 23 goals were scored were scored by Inder Singh!

He was selected in the Asian All-Stars team in 1967-1968. He was declared the "Best Right Out" in Asian Cup held at Tel Aviv in Israel in 1964. India was the runner-up there. He played for the JCT from 1974 to 1985. After his retirement, he was the manager of the JCT from 1985 to 2001. Since November 2001 he has been the Honorary Secretary of Punjab Football Association and also represents as member from North India in All India Football Federation's Executive Committee.

Inder Singh played in the Merdeka Football Tournament in Malaysia. Interestingly, the then-Prime-Minister of Malaysia, Mr Tinku Abdul Rehman, became his fan so much that he offered him a monthly salary of Rs 23,000 in 1967! The PM offered him five years' contract. But Inder Singh turned down the offer, as he wanted to play for Punjab and India. "Some of my friends then called me a sentimental fool to have rejected the offers," recalls Inder Singh. Later, the Mohan Bagan Club of West Bengal offered him a blank cheque. The Khalsa Sporting Club, Canada, also made a plum offers to him, but he stuck to his roots.

Asian Star Footballer S. Parminder Singh



Parminder Singh (renowned as Asian Star Footballer) joined JCT as Football Coach in the year 1995. He is graduate and has done Diploma in Football Coaching from Sports Authority of India (NIS Diploma) and has done AFC (Asian Football Confederation) "A", "B" & "C" Licence Coaching Courses. Besides this he has done AFC "B" & "C" Licence Conditioning Courses. He was one of the participants in FIFA Futuro-III Administration & Management Course which was conducted at AIFF Football House, New Delhi. During His playing career, Mr. Parminder Singh Kang has set a record of playing 19 years for JCT and in that period he had represented JCT in 19 Federation Cups, 19 Santosh Trophies. He had the honour to represent India Team in various International Assignments in the years 1975 to 1986. Mr. Parminder Singh Kang has brought Laurels for JCT and Punjab State by winning Major ALL India Tournaments for JCT and Santosh Trophies for Punjab State. He was declared as "Best Player of the decades" by AIFF in the year 1992. He had the honour to represent India as member of "Asian All Star Football Team". He was conferred with "Maharaja Ranjit Singh Award" (a top level state award) by Government of Punjab in the year 1983. He was also declared as "Best Player of the year 1984" by Delhi Sports Journalists Association, New Delhi.

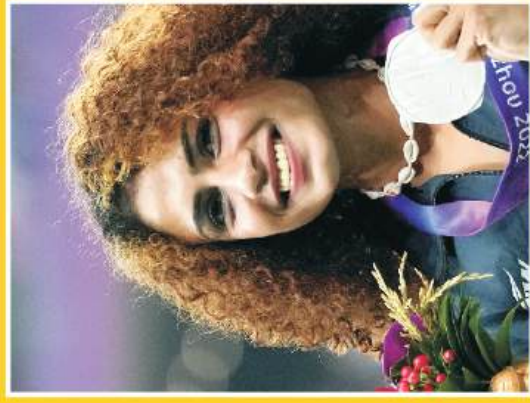

ਜਿਵੇਂ ਸੰਸਾਰਪੁਰ ਨੂੰ ਹਾਕੀ ਦਾ ਘਰ ਕਿਹਾ ਜਾਂਦਾ ਹੈ ਉਸੇ ਤਰ੍ਹਾਂ ਮਾਹਿਲਪੁਰ ਇਲਾਕੇ ਨੂੰ ਫੁੱਟਬਾਲ ਦੀ ਨਰਸਰੀ ਆਖਿਆ ਜਾਂਦਾ ਹੈ। ਇਸ ਮਾਣ ਨੂੰ ਪ੍ਰਾਪਤ ਕਰਨ ਲਈ ਇਥੋਂ ਦੇ ਬਜ਼ੁਰਗਾਂ ਅਤੇ ਵੱਡੇ ਵਡੇਰਿਆਂ ਨੇ ਆਪਣੀ ਮਿਹਨਤ ਤੇ ਲਗਨ ਨਾਲ ਇਥੇ ਫੁੱਟਬਾਲ ਦਾ ਬੂਟਾ ਲਾਇਆ। ਫਿਰ ਇਸਦੀ ਪਾਲਣ ਪੋਸ਼ਣ ਕਰਨ ਵਾਲੇ ਕੋਚ ਅਤੇ ਅਧਿਆਪਕ ਪੈਦਾ ਕੀਤੇ, ਜਿਨ੍ਹਾਂ ਨੇ ਸਕੂਲਾਂ ਅਤੇ ਕਾਲਜਾਂ ਵਿਚ ਫੁੱਟਬਾਲ ਦਾ ਜਾਗ ਲਾ ਕੇ ਨਵੀਂ ਪਨੀਰੀ ਦੀ ਕਾਂਟ ਛਾਂਟ ਕੀਤੀ। ਉਹਨਾਂ ਦੀ ਬਦੌਲਤ ਅਜ ਵੀ ਇਸ ਧਰਤੀ ਨੂੰ ਪੂਰੀ ਦੁਨੀਆ ਵਿਚ ਫੁੱਟਬਾਲ ਦੀ ਨਰਸਰੀ ਵਜੋਂ ਜਾਣਿਆ ਜਾਂਦਾ ਹੈ। 1987 ਤੋਂ 1997 ਤਕ ਦਾ ਉਹ ਸਮਾਂ ਸੀ ਜਦੋਂ ਇਸ ਧਰਤੀ ਤੇ ਨਿਵੇਕਲੇ ਸਾਹਿਤਕ ਅਤੇ ਸੱਭਿਆਚਾਰਕ ਮੇਲਿਆਂ ਦਾ ਬੋਲ-ਬਾਲਾ ਸੀ। 1987 ਵਿਚ ਬਲਜਿੰਦਰ ਮਾਨ ਵਲੋਂ ਆਪਣੇ ਸਾਥੀਆਂ ਨਾਲ ਰਲ ਕੇ ਆਰੰਭ ਕੀਤੀ ਪੰਜਾਬੀ ਸਾਹਿਤ ਸਭਾ ਦੀ ਚੜ੍ਹਾਈ ਕਰਕੇ ਹੀ ਐਸ ਅਜ਼ੋਕ ਭੌਰਾ ਨੇ ਢਾਡੀ ਅਮਰ ਸਿੰਘ ਸ਼ੌਂਕੀ ਯਾਦਗਾਰੀ ਟਰੱਸਟ ਦੀ ਮਾਹਿਲਪੁਰ ਵਿਚ ਸਥਾਪਨਾ ਕੀਤੀ। ਜਿਸ ਵਲੋਂ ਇਕ ਦਹਾਕਾ ਵਿਸ਼ਵ ਪ੍ਰਸਿੱਧ ਬਾਲ ਮੇਲੇ ਅਤੇ ਸ਼ੌਂਕੀ ਸੱਭਿਆਚਾਰਕ ਮੇਲੇ ਦੀ ਪੁੰਮ ਪੂਰੀ ਦੁਨੀਆ ਵਿਚ ਪੈਂਦੀ ਰਹੀ। ਇੰਡੀਆ ਬੁਕ ਆਫ ਰਿਕਾਰਡਸ ਵਿਚ ਦਰਜ ਬਾਲ ਰਸਾਲੇ ਨਿੱਕੀਆਂ ਕਰੁੰਬਲਾਂ ਦਾ ਆਰੰਭ 1995 ਵਿਚ ਇਹਨਾਂ ਸਤੁਰਾਂ ਦੇ ਲੇਖਕ ਵਲੋਂ ਕੀਤਾ ਗਿਆ।

ਬਜ਼ੁਰਗਾਂ ਦੇ ਕਹਿਣ ਅਨੁਸਾਰ ਬਜਵਾੜੇ ਲਾਗਲੀ ਛਾਉਣੀ ਵਿਚ ਅੰਗਰੇਜ਼ ਫੁੱਟਬਾਲ ਖੇਡਿਆ ਕਰਦੇ ਸਨ। ਜਿਥੇ ਇਸ ਇਲਾਕੇ ਦੇ ਫੌਜੀ ਇਸ ਖੇਡ ਨੂੰ ਆਪੋ ਆਪਣੇ ਪਿੰਡਾਂ ਭਾਵ ਮਾਹਿਲਪੁਰ ਇਲਾਕੇ ਵਿਚ ਲੈ ਆਏ। ਇਹਨਾਂ ਲੋਕਾਂ ਨੇ ਇਸ ਖੇਡ ਨੂੰ ਇੰਨਾ ਪਿਆਰ ਤੇ ਸਤਿਕਾਰ ਦਿੱਤਾ ਕਿ ਮਾਹਿਲਪੁਰ ਦਾ ਜ਼ਿਕਰ ਫੁੱਟਬਾਲ ਦੇ ਜ਼ਿਕਰ ਤੋਂ ਬਿਨਾਂ ਕੀਤਾ ਹੀ ਨਹੀਂ ਜਾ ਸਕਦਾ। ਬਸ ਫਿਰ ਤਾਂ ਹਰ ਪਾਸੇ ਫੁੱਟਬਾਲ ਦੀ ਹੀ ਬਾਤ ਪੈਣ ਲੱਗ ਪਈ। ਅਜ ਵੀ ਹਰ ਤੀਸਰੇ ਪਿੰਡ ਵਿਚ ਖੇਡ ਪ੍ਰੇਮੀਆਂ ਵਲੋਂ ਆਹਲਾ ਦਰਜੇ ਦੇ ਫੁੱਟਬਾਲ ਮੈਦਾਨ ਅਤੇ ਸਟੇਡੀਅਮ ਉਸਾਰੇ ਜਾ ਚੁੱਕੇ ਹਨ, ਜਿਨ੍ਹਾਂ ਵਿਚ ਸ਼ਾਮ ਸਵੇਰੇ ਅਭਿਆਸ ਅਤੇ ਸਲਾਨਾ ਟੂਰਨਾਮੈਂਟ ਚੱਲਦੇ ਰਹਿੰਦੇ ਹਨ। ਇੰਜ ਹਰ ਪਿੰਡ ਅਤੇ ਸਕੂਲ ਵਿਚ ਫੁੱਟਬਾਲ ਦੀ ਖੇਡ ਨੂੰ ਤਰਜੀਹੀ ਅਧਾਰ ਤੇ ਖਿਡਾਇਆ ਅਤੇ ਸਿਖਾਇਆ ਜਾਂਦਾ ਹੈ। ਇਸ ਇਲਾਕੇ ਦੀ ਫਿਜ਼ਾ ਵਿਚ ਰੁਮਕਦੀ ਪੌਣ ਵੀ ਫੁੱਟਬਾਲ ਦਾ ਹੀ ਸੁਨੇਹਾ ਦਿੰਦੀ ਪ੍ਰਤੀਤ ਹੁੰਦੀ ਹੈ। ਪਿੰਡ ਖੇੜਾ, ਪਾਲਦੀ ਬੱਡੋਂ, ਨੰਗਲ ਖਿਡਾਰੀਆਂ, ਕਾਲੇਵਾਲ ਭਗਤਾਂ, ਬਾਹੋਵਾਲ, ਚੰਦੇਲੀ, ਹੱਲੂਵਾਲ, ਕੈਂਡੋਵਾਲ ਸਮੇਤ ਹਰ ਤੀਸਰੇ ਪਿੰਡ ਵਿਚ ਅਜਕਲ ਟੂਰਨਾਮੈਂਟ ਕਰਵਾਏ ਜਾ ਰਹੇ ਹਨ। ਪੰਜਾਬ ਸਰਕਾਰ ਨੂੰ ਚਾਹੀਦਾ ਹੈ ਕਿ ਇਲਾਕੇ ਦੇ ਪਿੰਡਾਂ ਦੇ ਜੋਨ ਬਣਾ ਕੇ ਸੈਟਰ ਵਾਲੇ ਪਿੰਡ ਵਿਚ ਸਟੇਡੀਅਮ ਅਤੇ ਅਧੁਨਿਕ ਸਹੂਲਤਾਂ ਸਮੇਤ ਮਾਹਿਰ ਕੋਚਾਂ ਦਾ ਪ੍ਰਬੰਧ ਕਰੇ।

ਇਹ ਇੱਕ ਅੰਤਰ ਰਾਜੀ, ਰਾਸ਼ਟਰੀ ਪੱਧਰ ਦਾ ਟੂਰਨਾਮੈਂਟ ਹੈ ਜਿਸ ਵਿੱਚ ਭਾਰਤ ਦੇ ਸਾਰੇ ਰਾਜ, ਕੇਂਦਰੀ ਸ਼ਸਿਤ ਪ੍ਰਦੇਸ਼ਾਂ ਤੋਂ ਇਲਾਵਾ ਭਾਰਤੀ ਰੇਲਵੇ ਅਤੇ ਸਰਵਸਿਸ ਖੇਡ ਬੋਰਡ ਦੀਆਂ ਟੀਮਾਂ ਸਮੇਤ ਕੁੱਲ 38 ਟੀਮਾਂ ਭਾਗ ਲੈਂਦੀਆਂ ਹਨ। ਸਾਲ 2022 ਤੋਂ ਬਾਅਦ ਸੰਤੋਸ਼ ਟ੍ਰਾਫੀ ਨੂੰ ਪੰਜ ਤੋਂ ਵਧਾ ਕੇ ਛੇ ਗਰੁੱਪਾਂ ਵਿੱਚ ਵੰਡ ਦਿੱਤਾ ਗਿਆ ਅਤੇ ਇਸ ਸਾਲ ਇਹ ਮੁਕਾਬਲਾ ਨੌਂ ਗਰੁੱਪਾਂ ਵਿੱਚ ਖੇਡਿਆ ਜਾ ਰਿਹਾ ਹੈ ਜਿਨ੍ਹਾਂ ਦਾ ਆਯੋਜਨ ਭਾਰਤ ਦੇ ਨੌਂ ਸ਼ਹਿਰਾਂ, ਮਾਹਿਲਪੁਰ (ਪੰਜਾਬ), ਮੇਰਠ (ਉੱਤਰ ਪ੍ਰਦੇਸ਼), ਅਗਰਤਲਾ (ਤ੍ਰਿਪੁਰਾ), ਸ਼ਿਲੋਂਗ (ਮੇਘਾਲਿਆ), ਨਰਾਇਣਪੁਰ (ਛਤੀਸਗੜ੍ਹ) ਅਨੰਤਪੁਰ (ਆਂਧਰਾ ਪ੍ਰਦੇਸ਼) ਬੇਂਗਲੁਰੂ (ਕਰਨਾਟਕਾ), ਜੈਪੁਰ (ਰਾਜਸਥਾਨ) ਅਤੇ ਦਿੱਲੀ ਵਿੱਚ ਸੰਬੰਧਤ ਰਾਜ ਦੇ ਫੁੱਟਬਾਲ ਐਸੋਸੀਏਸ਼ਨਾਂ ਦੁਆਰਾ ਕੀਤਾ ਜਾ ਚੁੱਕਾ ਹੈ, ਜਦਕਿ ਫਾਈਨਲ ਰਾਊਂਡ ਆਸਾਮ ਵਿੱਚ ਖੇਡਿਆ ਜਾਵੇਗਾ। ਟੂਰਨਾਮੈਂਟ ਦੇ ਫਾਈਨਲ ਰਾਊਂਡ ਵਿੱਚ ਕੁੱਲ 12 ਟੀਮਾਂ ਭਾਗ ਲੈਣਗੀਆਂ। ਨੌਂ ਗਰੁੱਪਾਂ ਵਿੱਚੋਂ ਨੌਂ ਟੀਮਾਂ ਪੰਜਾਬ, ਉੱਤਰਾਖੰਡ, ਰਾਜਸਥਾਨ, ਰੇਲਵੇਜ਼, ਨਾਗਾਲੈਂਡ, ਮੇਘਾਲਿਆ, ਓਡੀਸ਼ਾ, ਤਾਮਿਲਨਾਡੂ, ਸਰਵਿਸਜ਼ ਨੇ ਆਪਣੇ ਗਰੁੱਪਾਂ ਵਿੱਚ ਅੱਵਲ ਰਹਿਣ ਤੇ ਫਾਈਨਲ ਗੇੜ ਵਿੱਚ ਪ੍ਰਵੇਸ਼ ਪੱਕਾ ਕਰ ਲਿਆ ਹੈ, ਜਦਕਿ ਦੋ ਟੀਮਾਂ ਪਿਛਲੇ ਸਾਲ ਦਾ ਫਾਈਨਲ ਮੈਚ ਖੇਡਣ ਵਾਲੀਆਂ (ਬੰਗਾਲ ਅਤੇ ਕੇਰਲਾ) ਟੀਮਾਂ ਅਤੇ ਇੱਕ ਫਾਈਨਲ ਰਾਊਂਡ ਦੀ ਮੇਜ਼ਬਾਨ ਟੀਮ (ਆਸਾਮ) ਨੂੰ ਨਿਯਮਾਂ ਅਨੁਸਾਰ ਆਖਰੀ ਗੇੜ ਵਿੱਚ ਪ੍ਰਵੇਸ਼ ਦਿੱਤਾ ਗਿਆ ਹੈ।

ਹੁਣ ਤੱਕ ਬੰਗਾਲ ਰਾਜ ਇਸ ਖੇਡ ਮੁਕਾਬਲੇ ਨੂੰ ਸਭ ਤੋਂ ਵੱਧ 33 ਵਾਰ ਜਿੱਤ ਚੁੱਕਾ ਹੈ ਅਤੇ ਉਹ 14 ਵਾਰ ਦੂਜੇ ਸਥਾਨ ਤੇ ਰਿਹਾ ਹੈ। ਬੰਗਾਲ ਤੋਂ ਬਾਅਦ ਪੰਜਾਬ ਦਾ ਨੰਬਰ ਆਉਂਦਾ ਹੈ ਪੰਜਾਬ ਨੇ ਇਹ ਟ੍ਰਾਫੀ ਦਾ ਖਿਤਾਬ 8 ਵਾਰ ਆਪਣੇ ਨਾਮ ਕੀਤਾ ਹੈ ਅਤੇ 8 ਵਾਰ ਹੀ ਦੂਜੇ ਸਥਾਨ ਤੇ ਰਿਹਾ ਹੈ। ਕੇਰਲਾ ਇਸ ਸੂਚੀ ਵਿੱਚ ਤੀਜੇ ਨੰਬਰ ਤੇ ਹੈ।

ਪੰਜਾਬੀ ਟੀਮਾਂ ਦਾ ਸੰਤੋਸ਼ ਟ੍ਰਾਫੀ ਵਿੱਚ ਪ੍ਰਦਰਸ਼ਨ ਬਹੁਤ ਸ਼ਾਨਦਾਰ ਰਿਹਾ ਹੈ। ਪੰਜਾਬ ਫੁੱਟਬਾਲ ਦੇ ਸਰਦਾਰ, ਜਰਨੈਲ ਸਿੰਘ ਦੁਆਰਾ ਤਿਆਰ ਕੀਤੀ ਫੁੱਟਬਾਲ ਟੀਮ ਨੇ 1974-75 ਜਲੰਧਰ ਦੀ ਸੰਤੋਸ਼ ਟ੍ਰਾਫੀ ਜਿੱਤ ਕੇ ਭਾਰਤੀ ਫੁੱਟਬਾਲ ਸੰਸਾਰ ਚ ਇੱਕ ਨਵਾਂ ਅਧਿਆਏ ਲਿਖ ਦਿੱਤਾ ਸੀ। ਜਦੋਂ ਪੰਜਾਬ ਦੀ ਟੀਮ ਨੇ ਕੁੱਲ 46 ਗੋਲ ਕੀਤੇ ਸਨ ਜਿਨ੍ਹਾਂ ਵਿੱਚੋਂ 23 ਗੋਲ ਇਕੱਲੇ ਸਰਦਾਰ ਇੰਦਰ ਸਿੰਘ ਦੁਆਰਾ ਕੀਤੇ ਗਏ ਸਨ ਅਤੇ ਇਹ ਕੀਰਤੀਮਾਨ ਅੱਜ ਤੱਕ ਬਰਕਰਾਰ ਹੈ।

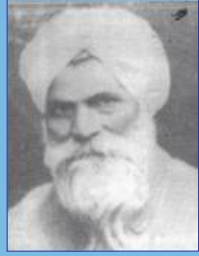

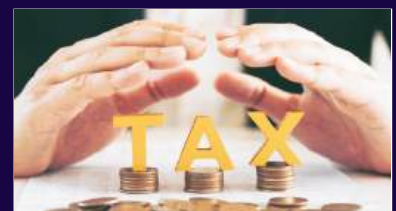

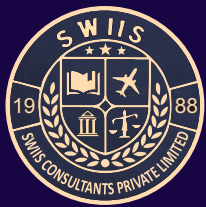
